*New Findings about Ice Age Flooding
in the Pasco Basin and Grand Coulee*

Dr. Spencer will speak on two topics of his recently published research, conducted with undergraduate Geology majors at Whitman:

- Missoula Flood processes, absolute ages, new fossils, and previously unrecognized shoreline deposits of temporary Lake Lewis in SE Washington, and
- The Steamboat Rock Silt: Indirect evidence for a moraine-dammed lake in upper Grand Coulee during the last glacial maximum.

Meeting time and place: Monday, March 1, 2010, 7 p.m., at the South County Senior Center, 220 Railroad Ave., on the waterfront in Edmonds. The Center is a short distance south of the ferry dock, midway between Main and Dayton Sts., and opposite the Amtrak station. There is off-street parking.
